### **Weather Summary/Alert:**

In the last seven days (4 – 10 June, 2021), there was 2.0 mm rain and the sky was partly to dense cloudy. The maximum & minimum temperatures ranged between 31.6 to 38.5°C and 19.9 to 27.3°C respectively. Relative humidity ranges from 60 to 98 % at 0712 a.m. and 32 to 67 % at 1412 hrs. The winds run mainly from the N & ESE with a speed of 1.7 to 13.5 km/hour. Light to moderate rain may occur in the coming five days. Wind will blow with a speed of 12.0-16.0 km/hr from the SE direction. Maximum & minimum temperature may range from 30.0 to 33.0 deg C & 19.0 to 25.0 deg C respectively. As per ERFS products, rainfall will be above normal & maximum & minimum temperature will be below normal from 16 - 22 June in the state. There is a warning of thunderstorm accompanied with lightning and intense shower and gusty winds (30-40 kmph) likely to occur at isolated places in the coming five days.

### **General Advisory:**

In view of the second wave of Corona (Covid-19), the farmers are advised to follow the guidelines given by the Government of India, personal hygiene, use of masks, washing hands at appropriate intervals during agricultural operations. NDVI & SPI map received from the India Meteorological Department dated indicated that the NDVI ranged between 0.1-0.3 for Udham Singh Nagar i.e. agriculture vigor is moderate in the district. SPI map indicates the severely wet conditions in the district for the past 4 weeks.

### **SMS Advisory:**

Light to moderate rain may occur in the coming five days.

SUGARCANE	Keeping in view the forecast of rain in coming days, postpone the irrigation in sugarcane crop.
