### **Outstanding Alumnus Award of College of Agriculture**

**Dr. Ashok K Mishra**

Ashok K. Mishra, Id No. 14772, Batch 1985, is Kemper and Ethel Marley Foundation Chair, Morrison School of Agribusiness, WP Carey School of Business, at the Arizona State University, USA, where he conducts research and teaching activities in agribusiness, food security, public policy and finance. Dr. Mishra has published more than 135 papers in Peer Reviewed Journals, 1 edited book, 12 book chapters, and more than 190 presentations at national and international conferences. This publication record has yielded 3,569 citations.

The quality of his research output has been recognized through several awards, most notably, the outstanding journal article award, in the agricultural economics profession's premier journal, the American Journal of Agricultural Economics. It also includes the outstanding journal article award in the Journal of Agricultural and Applied Economics. In 2013, Louisiana State University (LSU) recognized his research efforts by honoring him with a 2012 Mid-Career Scholar Rainmaker Award. In addition, he also received the 2013 LSU Distinguished Faculty Award from LSU and the 2012 LSU Gamma Sigma Delta Research Certificate Merit. 2013 Distinguished Achievement in Agriculture Award from LSU Gamma Sigma Delta Honor Society.

Dr Mishra is currently serving as Editors of Journal of Agribusiness in Developing and Emerging Economies (JADEE); Co-Editor of Agricultural Economics: An International Journal; he served as a (1) Co-editor of Applied Economic Perspectives and Policy (2011-2013); (2) Associate editor of the Agricultural Finance Review journal (2010 to present); (3) Co-editor of the Journal of Agricultural and Applied Economics (2007-2010); and (4) as a guest editor for Land Use Policy Journal, 2012. Chairman of the AAEA Selected Paper Committee (2008-2009). Chairman Economics Statistics and Information Resources Committee (ESIRC) of the AAEA; Council on Food, Agricultural and Resource Economics (C-FARE) for 2013-2017.

Dr. Mishra has presented his work to non-academics such as OECD, OMB, CEA. Dr. Mishra served on the Advisory Board of European Commission on Agriculture Reform; Advisory Board of Italian Ministry of Education University and Research. He has extensive work in development economics with CGIAR institutes such as IRRI, ICRISAT, CIMMYT, and IFPRI.

Prior to joining ASU, he held positions at Louisiana State University (2007-2015), Economic Research Service, U. S. Department of Agriculture, in Washington DC (197-2007). Dr. Mishra received a PhD in Economics at North Carolina State University (1996), a M. Sc in Agricultural Economics at the University of Aberdeen, United Kingdom (1989) and B. Sc. Ag & AH from G.B. Pant University of Ag. & Tech., Pantnagar, India.
