

**REGULATIONS FOR PANTNAGAR e CONNECTIONS AWARD FOR ALL ROUND STUDENT**

11. An award to be named as “**Pantnagar e Connections Award**” shall be awarded to the all-round best student of the University on the basis of the composite index for academic as well as co-curricular and extra-curricular activities. Anybody who completes his/her pre final year degree (III<sup>rd</sup> year for College of Agriculture, Fisheries and IV<sup>th</sup> year for College of Veterinary) from any college of the University shall be considered for this award.

At the end of pre final year degree the Secretary will notify that all the students desirous for being considered for the **Pantnagar e Connections Award** should submit their candidature along with all supporting documents.

12. The student who fulfils the following requirements shall be eligible for being considered for the award:

- (d) That he/she should have obtained a cumulative grade point average of 7.500 or above out of 10.000 at the end of the pre final degree programme.
- (e) (i) That he/she should not have been on “Academic Probation” at any time during his/her stay at this University.
- (ii) He/she should not have been awarded any punishment under Clause 47 of the Regulations on Continuance of Studies. (Including AP/CP)
- (f) That he/she should actively participated in extra-curricular/co-curricular activity and should have secured at least fifty percent marks, out of a total 25 in co-curricular/extra-curricular activities.

13. The students who are eligible for this award on the basis of the criteria laid down in the clause 2 above shall be evaluated by awarding marks as follows:

(c) For academic performance	75 marks
(d) For performance in co-curricular and extra-curricular activities excluding work programme.	25 marks

14. The marks for academic performance shall be calculated by multiplying the CGPA by 7.5. For example, if a student obtained an OGPA of 7.500 out of 10.000 the percentage of marks for the purpose will be  $7.500 \times 7.5 = 56.25$ .

15. The marks for performance in co-curricular and extra-curricular activities, as in clause 3(b) above, shall be awarded on the following basis:

iv) Games/Sports/ NCC/NSS	b. Games/ Sports: 2 marks for each year for being member of any university team c. NCC/NSS: 3 marks for NCC/NSS ‘B’ certificate and 5 marks for NCC ‘C’ certificate	Maximum 9 marks
v) Professional Societies	e. Professional Societies:1 mark for each year of membership (maximum 4.0 marks) f. For holding positions in Executive Committee of Professional Societies: 2 marks for each year (maximum 4.0 marks)	Maximum 8 marks
vi) Winning prize at the Intersarsity/State/ National/University Level	e. Representing the University in Intersarsity/State/National level in any year (Maximum 1 mark for participation) f. Intersarsity/State/National level participation resulting in winning or prizes for each year: 4. First prize 3.0 marks	Maximum 8 marks

	5. Second Prize            2.0 marks 6. Third Prize                1.0 mark (Maximum 3.0 marks) g. Winning prizes at University level for each year: 4. First Prize                1.5 marks 5. 16. After grading the eligible candidates for the award on the basis of clause (3), (4) and (5) above, the committee shall scrutinize the proposals and finalize the recommendations.

17. In case of tie,

I. Award will be given on the basis of Academic performance

II. If equal marks obtained in academic performance, then rank of the entrance exam will be considered.

III. If above two conditions also matched, then the award money shall be among the two candidates SECURING EQUAL MARKS.

18. The award will be given at the annual Alumni Meet of the university every year and shall commence from the year 2021.

Any matter not provided in these regulations shall be determined by the Vice-Chancellor on the recommendation of the committee.
